SEEKING PARTICIPANTS

**SCHOOL-AGE
LEARNERS**

- Is your child Primary or Highschool aged?
- Are they formally identified as gifted AND formally identified with disability?
- Do you live in South East Queensland?
- Participants must have parent/guardian permission.

RESEARCH STUDY

- Sense of belonging is a universal human need, where both ourselves and others can feel accepted, seen and valued, promoting wellbeing.
- Research suggests twice-exceptional individuals are likely to experience difficulties with belonging
- Participants will take part in 3 in-person 30min interviews over 4-6 weeks (researcher will come to you)
- Participants will be asked to share their personal interest
- The aim is to understand experiences of belonging and non-belonging for twice-exceptional learners
- Findings will inform policy and practice
